Town Hall Arts Center Presents *The Robber Bridegroom*

LITTLETON, CO – The fifth musical production in Town Hall Arts Center's 2016-2017 Season is *The Robber Bridegroom*. Book by Alfred Uhry, music by Robert Waldman, lyrics by Alfred Uhry. Based on the novella by Eudora Welty. Set in eighteenth century Mississippi, the musical follows Jamie Lockhart, a rascally robber of the woods, as he courts Rosamund, the only daughter of the richest planter in the country. The proceedings go awry, however, thanks to a case of double-mistaken identity. Throw in an evil stepmother, intent on Rosamund's demise, her pea-brained henchman, and a hostile talking head-in-a-trunk, and you get a rollicking country romp. With its irresistibly catchy bluegrass score, colorful cast, and unique form of storytelling, *The Robber Bridegroom* is a hidden gem!

THAC favorites **Bob Wells** and **Donna Debreceni** are collaborating again to bring you this "rollicking good time, a mighty Mississippi of fun!" —Jesse Oxfeld, *Entertainment Weekly*. **Bob Wells**, recently at THAC directing the nearly sold out run of *Avenue Q*, directs *The Robber Bridegroom*. Wells serves as one of the resident directors at Town Hall Arts Center and has also directed *Once Upon a Mattress*, this season. Bob has received several honors for his work including Henry Awards and Marlowe Awards. Musical direction is by **Donna Kolpan Debreceni** and **Mitch Jervis**. Donna was last seen directing music for *Bonnie & Clyde*, *Avenue Q*, and *A Christmas Story* this season. Donna is a Henry Award Winner for THAC's 2012 production of *The Who's Tommy*. **Kelly Kates** is choreographing the show, most recently at Town Hall choreographing *Once Upon a Mattress*.

Donna Debreceni will be doing double duty, playing keyboards and leading a **live band** for the run of the production, including: **Deborah Fuller** on Violin, **David Waldman** on violin, **Mitch Jervis** on guitars, and **Scott Alan Smith** on guitars.

Featured actors in this production are **Ryan Buehler** as *Jamie Lockhart* and **Rebekah Ortiz** as *Rosamund*. Ryan is returning to THAC after last being seen in 2016's *Legally Blonde*. Rebekah was last seen as Fiona in the 2015 production of *Shrek*. We also welcome back **TJ Hogle** as *Clement*, TJ was last seen at Town Hall as *Trekkie Monster* in *Avenue Q*. **Steph Holmbo** makes her Town Hall debut as *Salome*, Steph recently graduated from New York University's Atlantic Theatre Company.
