Rita Campbell is a resident of Kent Village, Englewood, CO. When she retired from the University of Denver her husband gave her a gift certificate to Judy Patti’s Painting Studio in Littleton as a Christmas present. This was her very first introduction to watercolor art and she continues training with Judy.

Rita holds a BSBA degree in Marketing from the University of Denver. She is active in the community and is currently on the Arapahoe County 4-H Foundation Board, the Denver University Retiree Board of Directors and an officer in her P.E.O. Sorority.

Patricia Barr Clarke is a plein air painter of watercolors. She loves to travel and enjoy the spontaneity of painting on location as the light changes. Most recently she spent ten days in Curacao conducting workshops and exhibiting my work. Earlier in the year, she painted in Barcelona and the region of Aragon.

Patricia is a signature member of the Colorado and Kansas Watercolor Societies. She is also a long time member of the Denver Art Student League, where she has exhibited her work at the Summer Art Market for over 20 years and Plein Air Artists of Colorado.

Patricia has a BA from Kansas University and an MA from the American University in Cairo, Egypt. She teaches classes for the Heritage Art Guild, the Art Garage and other Denver area art groups and watercolor workshops in Colorado, New Mexico, and Curacao.

Christopher Clark is a local Denver artist, specializing in oil paintings of many subjects: romance, dancing, music, Italy, animals, and Denver cityscapes. His impressionist style is compelled by bold brushwork, brilliant colors, and a luminous sense of light. Christopher is available for commissions of all kinds.

After a successful business career **Susan Gordon** started her Art career. She spent most of her adult life as an entrepreneur creating and growing successful businesses. After her husband and she sold our last business, she started my Art career. She took classes in watercolor and acrylic. Susan took workshops with local and national artists. She devoured books on technique and sat for hours in my home studio practicing what she’d learned. She still does. Being an artist is a journey.

Her hope is for the Joy she feels in the process to come through in the painting. So that when someone looks at her art, they too will feel JOY!!
